We have plans to make Weston General Hospital better. We want you to help us make our plans happen.

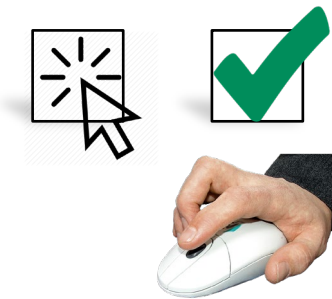


We have written some questions for you to answer. This is called a **survey**.

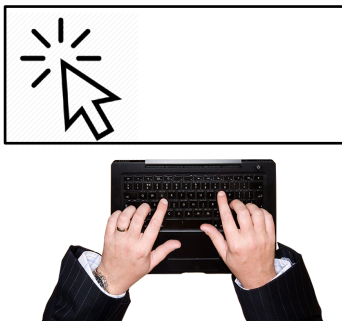

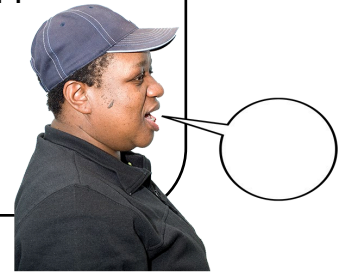

Help for people who are away from home



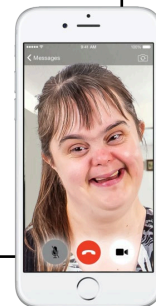
Our plans mean some people will be moved to a different hospital where they can get the care they need.

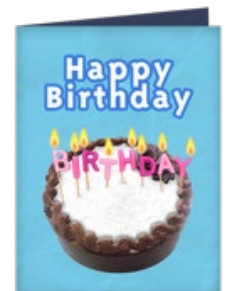

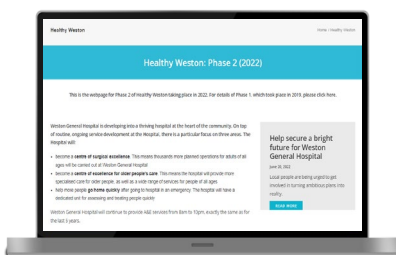
We will listen and think about what you tell us.
