

## **Quick Reference Guide - GP Record**

## Viewing the GP Record

Information collected from GP Systems can be viewed using the **GP Record** tab, which is located to the right of the **Timeline** tab in the individuals Connecting Care Record.

• Click on the **GP Record** tab, which should now be visible to the right of the '**Person Summary'** tab as indicated

The default screen you will land on is the **GP view**, this shows administrative notes and Consultation note. These are time-limited (previous 12 months) and any consultation notes marked as 'confidential' by the GP are not shared.
