

## Quick Reference Guide - GP Record

### Viewing the GP Record


Information collected from GP Systems can be viewed using the **GP Record** tab, which is located to the right of the **Timeline** tab in the individuals Connecting Care Record.

- Click on the **GP Record** tab, which should now be visible to the right of the **'Person Summary'** tab as indicated



Information can now be viewed using the following categories,

which are shown in the left hand pane:



Data from GP Systems is requested in 'Real-time' by the CC system to give up to date information to the Clinician

It is possible that all the categories may not be visible due to the Access Rights you may have

The default screen you will land on is the **GP view**, this shows administrative notes and Consultation note. These are time-limited (previous 12 months) and any consultation notes marked as 'confidential' by the GP are not shared.
