Severe Mental Illness (SMI) Physical checks -six physical health checks are found on the GP Records Tab

1. Measurement of weight (BMI or BMI + Waist circumference) in the GP journal view
2. Blood pressure and pulse check (diastolic and systolic blood pressure recording + pulse rate) in GP examinations
3. Blood lipid including cholesterol test (cholesterol measurement or QRISK measurement) in GP investigations
4. Blood glucose test (blood glucose or HbA1c measurement) in GP investigations
5. Assessment of alcohol consumption both alcohol and smoking in GP journal view
6. Assessment of smoking status both alcohol and smoking in GP journal view
