

Quick Reference Guide – ReSPECT Plus (ReSPECT and End of Life) Record (EMIS data)


Bristol, North Somerset and South Gloucestershire (BNSSG) ICB have implemented a new End of Life/ReSPECT digital solution. This is called the Black Pear Shared Care Planning System.

From July 2023 this data can be seen in the document tab and is covered by a separate QRG which can be found here <u>QRG - Respect/End of Life New documents sourced from Black Pear</u>. End of Life/ReSPECT data will now be added directly to the Black Pear Shared Care Planning System, and this will contain much more information than the existing EMIS views.

We would strongly recommend that you always check for a more recent BNSSG ReSPECT Plus form in the 'Document' Tree (under the 'ReSPECT' heading) before looking at the old EMIS view detailed below.

This guide covers only the EMIS GP data that will be retained until April 2024, code mapping has been set up to continue saving this information in the existing EMIS GP views in Connecting Care. Not all Black Pear Shared Care Planning System codes have been mapped to EMIS GP codes.

A warning message will appear in the GP EMIS views recommending that the user should check whether there is a more up-to-date Black Pear ReSPECT Plus document for the patient.

The ReSPECT/End of Life information in Connecting Care is made up of five areas:

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- ReSPECT/End of Life Alert
- ReSPECT/End of Life Summary
- ReSPECT/End of Life Record
- ReSPECT/End of Life Document panel in the person summary view
- Full and summary ReSPECT/End of Life forms from Black Pear in the document view

Only the first three point are covered in this guide, the others are covered in the <u>QRG</u> - <u>Respect/End of Life New documents sourced from Black Pear guide</u>.

ReSPECT/End of Life Alert

On the **patient banner** you will see the **alert for the known ReSPECT/End of Life Record.** If a ReSPECT/End of Life Record has been shared the alert will be coloured red.



There are three options for this alert:

- 'ReSPECT/Known End of Life Record' this indicates the patient has a ReSPECT/End of Life Record in the EMIS GP system or the Black Pear Shared Care Planning System and will display in red.
- 'ReSPECT/No Known End of Life Record'- this indicates the patient does not have an EOL Record in EMIS GP system or Black Pear Shared Care Planning System and will display in blue.
- 'Unable to Load ReSPECT/End of Life Record' this indicates the patient has not
 consented to sharing their information with Connecting Care or there is a problem
 loading the record due to a technical issue. This will display in orange.

Click on the alert and then select 'more'




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This will take you to the 'ReSPECT/End of Life Summary' which is a snapshot of key ReSPECT/End of Life information. This is described in detail in the section below.

ReSPECT/End of Life Summary

This can be accessed either by clicking on the alert and following the instructions above or by clicking on the 'GP Records' tab and the 'ReSPECT/End of Life Summary'. A test record is shown below to demonstrate how to access the record.



The **ReSPECT/End of Life Summary** consists of the following sections:

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• **'Consent Status'** - this section contains consent to share the ReSPECT Plus (ReSPECT and End of Life Record) and best interest decision.

• **'Resuscitation Status'** - this section contains information on the patient's resus decision and if the patient, carer and family member have been informed.

• 'Main Carer' - this section contains information on whether the patient has a carer and their contact details.

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 'Lasting Power of Attorney for Health and Welfare' - this section shows information on the lasting power of attorney or has an appointed person with personal welfare lasting power of attorney with authority for life sustaining decisions.


This section will show information:

- o of the current relevant important problems
- o of any action points arising from the review
- o what predictable problems may arise and what could be done about them
- what is to be done if the patient deteriorates
- special notes commentary (for Out of Hours)

This section will display data recorded both before and after the introduction of the Black Pear Shared Care Planning System. However, from April 2022 If clinical recommendations for **emergency care and treatment** information that has been recorded in the Black Pear Shared Care Planning System they will not be visible under advance care planning in Connecting Care.

To see clinical recommendations for **emergency care and treatment** information that has been recorded in the Black Pear Shared Care Planning System you need to exit the ReSPECT /End of Life Summary and select the '**GP view**' from the '**GP record**' in the 'Document View' and find the most recent consultation by 'Dr Black Pear Connect'. In this consultation, you should look for the focus of care in the free text, and current clinical recommendations for **emergency care and treatment** will follow immediately afterwards.

• 'Advance Decision to Refuse Treatment [ADRT]' - this section shows if a patient has an ADRT or if a patient has a healthcare professional involved in discussions about ADRT.

• **'Preferred Place of Care'** - this section contains information on the patient's preferred place of care. If the patient has more than one choice this should be listed in the text associated with the first choice. This will also contain any other supporting comments e.g.

It will also show any information on whether this has been discussed with the patient and/or family or if the patient is unable to express a preference.

• **'Preferred Place of Death'** - this section contains information on the patient's preferred place of death. If the patient has more than one choice this should be listed in the text associated with the first choice.

• 'Anticipatory Medicines/Just in Case Box Issued' - this section covers the issue and prescription of palliative care anticipatory medication and just in case medications.


Note: For each update the coded information will be in **bold**, any associated text will not be in bold.

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ReSPECT/End of Life Record

This can be accessed either by clicking on the 'GP Records' tab and then 'ReSPECT/End of Life'.



The 'GP Record' 'ReSPECT/End of Life' tab will display information from the EMIS GP record and also information recorded from the Black Pear Shared Care Planning System. It also includes other codes that are present in a patient's GP record that support ReSPECT Plus (ReSPECT and End of Life).

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'ReSPECT/End of Life' consists of a series of tabs:

• **'EoL Care Status'** - this tab covers information covering consent status, prognosis, care plan narrative and gold standards palliative care framework.




The **'EoL Care Status'** tab may show some information in the Personal Care Plan section that may have been superseded by information in the Black Pear Shared Care Planning System. To see <u>additional</u> information recorded in the Black Pear Shared Care Planning System that is not shared in this tab you need to exit the end of life record and select the 'GP view' from the 'GP record' in the 'Document View' and find the most recent consultation by 'Dr Black Pear Connect'. In this consultation you should look for focus of care in the free text, and current clinical recommendations for emergency care and treatment will follow immediately afterwards. There is an example of how to do this on page 5 above.

• **'Social & Demographic'** - this tab covers information for language, religion, ethnicity and organ donation.


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 'Disabilities' - this tab covers information for disability and Australia-modified Karnofsky Performance Status scale.¹



'Frailty' - this tab covers information if the patient is mentally confused. If additional
frailty codes are present in a patient's GP record these will also display.



• 'Carers' - this tab covers information on whether the patient has a carer and their details, prognosis awareness and other professionals involved.

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
¹ Australia-modified Karnofsky Performance Status scale is measure of the patient's overall performance status or ability to perform their activities of daily living



- 'Advance Care Planning' this tab covers the following information:
 - preferred place of care discussion
 - o preferred place of care location
 - preferred place of death discussion
 - preferred place of death location
 - resus decision

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- legal advance decision to refuse treatment
- lasting power of attorney




The 'Advance care planning' tab may show some information in the Advance care planning section that may have been superseded by information in the Black Pear Shared Care Planning System. To see additional or newly added information recorded in the Black Pear Shared Care Planning System that is not shared in this tab you need to exit the End of Life record and select the 'GP view' from the 'GP record' in the 'Document View' and find the Page 10 of 14 July 2023

most recent consultation by 'Dr Black Pear Connect'. In this consultation, you should look for focus of care in the free text, and current clinical recommendations for emergency care and treatment will follow immediately afterwards.

There is an example of how to do this on page 5 above.


 'Last days of life' - this tab covers information on anticipatory medicines and syringe driver/pump & oxygen supply.



The 'Last days of life' tab may show some information in the 'Anticipatory Medicines /Just in Case Box issued' section that may have been superseded by information in the Black Pear Shared Care Planning System. To see <u>additional</u> information recorded in the Black Shared Care Planning System that is not shared in this tab you need to exit the End of Life record and select the 'GP view' from the 'GP record' in the 'Document View' and find the most recent consultation by 'Dr Black Pear Connect'. In this consultation you should look for focus of care in the free text, and current clinical recommendations for emergency care and treatment will follow immediately afterwards.

There is an example of how to do this on page 5 above.

• 'Death details' - this tab covers date of death, place of death and cause of death.



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Note: If a patient has been formally marked as deceased on the NHS Spine then you will not be able to view their GP or ReSPECT/End of Life Record. The last known GP practice and their contact details will display on the Care Network tab.


• **'Express Consent'** - this tab will show if the patient has consented to share additional information with the Summary Care Record.



Note: You may need to adjust the zoom on your browser to view the ReSPECT/End of Life Record.

Other GP Views

Some of the codes recorded in the EMIS GP End of Life recording templates and the Black Pear Shared Care Planning System will also display on other GP views in Connecting Care. E.g. Diagnosis information will also display under the 'Diagnosis' tab on 'GP Records'.



Viewing Updates to ReSPECT/End of Life Information

Note: Any updates made in Black Pear Shared Care Planning System will be shown in Connecting Care as a separate line item and will not overwrite any previous recording by the GP in their previous End of Life template in the EMIS GP System.

For example, if the patient changes their decision on the location for preferred place of death and care and this has been recorded in the Black Pear Shared Care Planning System

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


this will display as a separate entry for each. The latest code will appear at the top of the list.

Viewing Further Information

In both ReSPECT/End of Life summary and detailed data views to view more information on a given entry **click on any of the visible entries** to drill down.

From April 2022 ReSPECT PLUS (ReSPECT and End of Life) will be recorded in the Black Pear Shared Care Planning System. Agreed information from this system flows to the EMIS GP System and Connecting Care.

Full information about the care plan is contained in the Black Pear Shared Care Planning System. If you have access to the Black Pear Shared Care Planning System this will give a full history of the changes made to ReSPECT Plus (ReSPECT and End of Life) data from April 2022.

Within Connecting Care the person that recorded the data will now be shown as 'Dr Black Pear Connect'.

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If you don't have access to the Black Pear Shared Care Planning System you can check the copy of the ReSPECT Plus form that is printed and given to the patient. This shows the name of the clinician making the CPR decision, the name of the senior responsible clinician and the name of the person who last updated it.
