Important Information

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- The original copy of the ReSPECT form held by the patient is always the most up to date version.
- The ReSPECT/ End of Life Record alert in the Banner is only linked to the GP information

1. Viewing the ReSPECT information from GP record

A paper ReSPECT form has been implemented across BNSSG, together with a GP EMIS template and associated codes. <u>Click Here</u> to find out more about the national ReSPECT process.

In the hospital ReSPECT forms there is an additional section in 'action for GPs' asking for information to be coded in their electronic ReSPECT template in EMIS, including:

- DNACPR status,
- Clinical recommendations for emergency care and treatment
- A record of patient's consent to share End of Life record

If a person has an existing <u>End of Life template</u> in GP EMIS then these codes will pull across and be displayed in the End of Life record view in Connecting Care.
