This is the Primary Medical Services contract for the delivery of Primary Care service to members of the homeless community who are not registered with a mainstream Primary Care provider.</p> <p>The Homeless Health Service also delivers specialised services which are commissioned by the Local Authority.</p> <p>Primary Medical Services provided by Homeless Health Service under the APMS contract are:</p> <p>Essential Services</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Management of patients who are ill or believe themselves to be ill, with conditions from which recovery is generally expected, for the duration of that condition, including relevant health promotion advice and referral as appropriate, reflecting patient choice wherever practical • General management of patients who are terminally ill
