1. The name and contact e-mail address of the person responsible for Women's Health.	Dr Joanne Medhurst, Chief Medical Officer
2. Whether your ICB funds a menopause specialist clinic in your area.	No, patients with menopause symptoms requiring secondary care support are normally seen in Gynaecology services.
3. Whether your ICB funds menopause clinics in Primary Care.	The ICB does not currently fund menopause clinics in primary care. Some GP practices do offer menopause support through their practice nursing teams; how they wish to configure their teams is at the practice's discretion, based on local population need. The ICB does not hold information on which practices provide this support.
