	The BNSSG ICB Data Protection Officer (DPO) does not cover GP Practices. No additional funds are provided for this role and there is no dedicated contract which is subject to renewal. The role is conducted in addition to the post holder's permanent contracted responsibilities and duties.
	We have recently undergone open procurement for DPO services to support General Practice. This process has not yet concluded and will be available in the public domain once complete.
