Please could you provide the ICB's spend on Right to Choose assessments for 22/23 and 23/24 to date.	
Clarification received: Apologies! It would be Right to Choose in relation to ASD assessment. If there isn't a breakdown for just ASD then all ND as a whole would suffice.  If possible, split via children's and adult's spend, but a combined figure is acceptable if the ICB does not hold the information split via children's and adult's.	2022/23 spend on Right to Choose Providers was £2.1 million. 2023/24 spend on Right to Choose Providers was £3.4 million.  The ICB does not have a breakdown of spend for ASD assessments or spend for Children and Adults.
