1. Are you currently utilising ambient voice / ambient scribe/dictation technologies or a similar technology? If yes, please can you state the name of the supplier(s) used across your organisation?	BNSSG ICB does not use Ambient Voice technology. BNSSG ICB as an organisation does not use separate dictation technology, but staff have access to integrated dictation technologies such as Office Dictation in the Microsoft Office Suite. As part of a limited NHS Trial, staff also have the option to use CoPilot to assist with note taking and minuting of meetings within Microsoft Teams. Staff with a reasonable adjustment or Access to Work assessment identifying a need for specialist software including voice recognition
	or dictation technology are individual cases, and use a variety of programmes whose primary purpose is to support the individual with specific tasks and follow instructions, rather than any ambient technology. These are recommended orders placed with a variety of resellers, or a direct replacement (next version upgrades.)
