I would like to know which providers of right to choose adhd assessments have reached their agreed limit of activity and have been paused and which providers are still operating.	No Right to Choose providers should have ceased operating as a result of the commissioned service level for the year. When a Right to Choose provider reaches their indicative activity limit for the year, they should not be declining new referrals for assessments and instead, these should be placed on a waiting list until the following financial year. Any instances where an appointment booking has been made, or a patient has begun the medication process will not be impacted and will continue as normal. Providers should be publishing current waiting times on their websites.
