	HELP 4 PSYCHOLOGY SERVICES LTD Notes on data: • Due to the way invoices have historically been processed, all adult ADHD and Autism spend up to September 2024 was applied to the same invoicing budget code and it would not be possible to retrospectively split these out as far back as 23-24 within the 18 hour response timeframe. • Where a third party private provider offers both ADHD and Autism assessment services it can be common for them to consolidate all activity onto one single invoice. While all reasonable steps were taken to separate adult ADHD from adult Autism spend since September 2024, it is possible that the adult ADHD spend figure will still include some Autism activity, particularly where a provider offers combined assessments. • A number of third party private providers also offer both adult and CYP ADHD and Autism services and it is common for them to consolidate all activity onto one single invoice. Where this has been the case, all reasonable steps have been taken to separate the activity between CYP and adults, however, due to factors outside of our control, this has not always been possible to do, so some of the adult costs may include activity within CYP services. • Spend on CYP ADHD and Autism services is coded to one overall budget, and it would not be possible within the 18 hour limit to split out spend by assessment type for the period requested. • It is possible that invoices relating to 2025/26 activities may still be received.	£6,390
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	All spend with third party private providers is on the basis of activity, including that with our contracted provider, Clinical Partners. BNSSG ICB holds block contracts with Avon and Wiltshire Mental Health Partnership (AWP) NHS Trust for adult ADHD and Autism services and Sirona care & health CiC for CYP ADHD and Autism services. The information provided does not include spend on these contracts as the block extends beyond ADHD and Autism.
