Avon and Wiltshire Mental Health Partnership (AWP) NHS Trust is the provider of Dementia services for South Gloucestershire and North Somerset. Devon Partnership Trust (Bristol Dementia Wellbeing Service) is the provider of Dementia Services for Bristol.
2. Does the Dementia Assessment provide an MRI scan?	A dementia assessment can include an MRI scan if clinically appropriate as part of the assessment pathway.
