5. It is not possible to provide annual spend at the service level, because it is not possible to fully disaggregate Planned/Elective from Non-Elective activity within speciality service areas; nor scheduled from unscheduled diagnostics in all modalities.

The total across the Trusts for elective performance and diagnostics is £241.998m; £121.755m for North Bristol NHS Trust (NBT) and £120.243m for University Hospitals Bristol and Weston NHS Foundation Trust (UHBW).

The ICB has applied Section 43(2) to the disclosure of the annual spend for individual Independent Sector Providers. Section 43(2)

	exempts from disclosure information which would, or would be likely to, prejudice the commercial interests of an organisation. The ICB believes that disclosure of the information would prejudice the commercial interests of the providers named above. The ICB has previously contacted the providers who have confirmed that the information is considered commercially confidential to them. The ICB has considered the information provided by the providers when applying the public interest test to the exemption. The public interest arguments in favour of disclosing the information include the ICB's responsibility to be transparent and accountable in its decision making and to promote public understanding of how the NHS work. These services are paid for via public taxation and therefore the public has an interest in whether the services commissioned by the ICB represent value for money. The public interest argument in favour of maintaining the exemption considers the information provided from the providers that the information is commercially sensitive to them. The ICB has considered that disclosure may result in current providers and possibly future providers not offering services as potential disclosure of commercially sensitive information may constitute too high a risk. The ICB has a responsibility to secure the best use of public resources and provide value for money. To
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	achieve this, the ICB needs to have a wide range of organisations willing to offer services. In aggregate the total spend for the ISPs listed above in 2024/25 was circa £47.8 million. For Tariff per activity, see NHS England » NHS Payment Scheme. 6.
