Total Joined Conveyances: Total recorded ambulance dispatches from postcode BS35 4DF resulting in physical hospital conveyance within your commissioning footprint. 2. Hospital Outcome Metric: Total number of those entries that converted into an actual Inpatient Admission (requiring an overnight ward bed stay, rather than standard same-day discharge from A&E). 3. Mortality: Total number of those specific inpatient admissions resulting in on-site mortality prior to a formal hospital discharge.	The data requested is not held by the ICB in the format requested.
