Specifically, I require details regarding The Milton Surgery (232-234 Milton Road, Weston-super-Mare, BS22 8AG) covering the period between 1 September 2025 and 1 March 2026. Please provide the following information:	
1. Declared Measures: A list of all specific BMA collective action measures that The Milton Surgery officially notified the ICB they were enacting (for example, the implementation of a 25-patient daily contact cap, the withdrawal/pause of specific secondary Data Sharing Agreements (DSAs), or pushback on Advice and Guidance referral systems).	The ICB has had no communication from The Milton Surgery regarding GP Collective Action.
2. Impact Notifications: Copies of any formal notifications, operational risk assessments, or alert submissions sent by The Milton Surgery to the ICB regarding reduced operational capacity or service limitations during this timeframe.	
3. MDT and EHCH Variances: Any documented correspondence between the ICB and the surgery regarding adjustments to their capacity to deliver the Enhanced Health in Care Homes (EHCH) Directed
