BNSSG ICB (Bristol, North Somerset and South Gloucestershire Integrated Care Board) has a Dynamic Support Register (DSR), which is in development, and is currently a health only register that mental health colleagues can access to add individuals to the caseload held by the register. A whole system DSR is under development. This is managed within the Nursing and Quality directorate, however the ICB is currently undergoing an organisational restructure, therefore for the most appropriate contact as of today please see answer question 2.
